- Students will leave well-equipped for success in college or prepared to fill high-wage jobs in the building trades

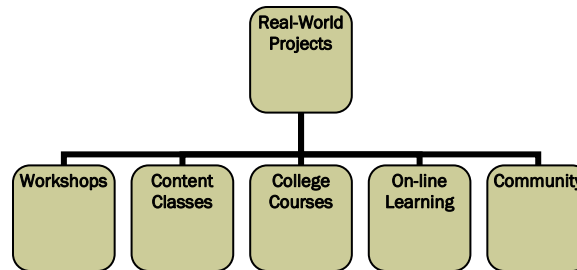
Relevant Learning
